

# Board of Directors Responsibilities

- Attend and engage in 80% (5 of 6) of the Board of Directors meetings each year.
- Actively participate on at least one committee (Board Development; Finance; Resource Development; or Senior Center).
- Attend at least two of our three major fundraising events and consider sponsoring\* at least one table (Inspiring Positive Aging Awards, Game On or Gala).
- Make a financial contribution in support of the Annual Board Fundraising Goal. The suggested amount is \$2,500, but any personally significant contribution is welcome.
- Participate in at least one program event/activity (e.g. All-Staff Meeting, Meals on Wheels Ride-a-long, Senior Center event or Community Dining Lunch).
- Be an ambassador and advocate for Sound Generations in the community (ex. Senior Lobby Day).
- Complete Board Commitment Form outlining commitment to above responsibilities.
- Complete the annual Diversity and Demographics survey.
- Participate in CEO Evaluation and organizational feedback

\*Sponsorship can take the form of purchasing a table and inviting guests, inviting guests who purchase their own seat, or helping to secure corporate sponsorship for an event.
